Ride Safe and Ride Often

Greetings from the Chapter's "Rider Educator"

Rider Safety: Just something I have noticed:

With the invention of Plexus, motorcyclists have a way of keeping the windshield spotless. It shines like a jewel and the motorcyclist can see perfectly clear for greater distances without dirt smears and rain drop spots obstructing the view. I have observed the ritual at different ride stops where the co-rider dismounts and gets the drinks to re-hydrate and the rider gets out the old rag and plexus and starts polishing that shield. Everyone walks around and talks about what they have just seen on the ride and then everyone mounts up and takes off again.

Just a question to think on: did you polish your helmet shield? How many thumb-prints have you accumulated from putting it on and pulling it off? Remember, you first have to see thru the helmet shield before your eyes look through the windshield. Also, if you wear sun-glasses or prescription glasses, give them a cleaning before mounting up also.

You might see more interesting things happening around you or spot that potential hazard in the road just a fraction sooner if all the different shields are cleaned at the same time and not just the one that looks the prettiest.

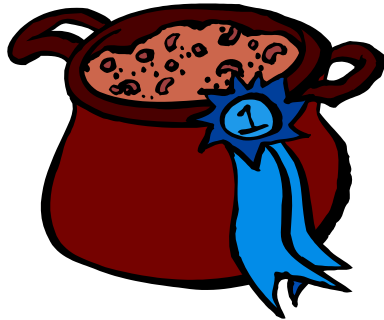
